## What the hack is a hackathon?

What happens if you get 80 or so tech-savvy brains in a room for a weekend -- ranging from students to experienced programmers -- and entice them with experts, data and sponsored cash prizes for the best solutions to Fraser Health's challenges? We don't exactly know, and that's the beauty of a hackathon: anything could happen.

A hackathon is an event where programmers and others involved in technology and software development collaborate and compete to develop solutions to specific challenges. The most promising ideas can be further developed into working systems.

Facebook's 'like' button and chat functions came out of company hackathons. In the health care world, data mining has uncovered a lung cancer treatment in an already-approved anti-depressant and apps have been created to help refugees navigate government services.

In a B.C. health authority first, Fraser Health is hosting our hackathon at Simon Fraser University's Surrey campus on

January 21 and 22 in conjunction with the City of Surrey and Innovation Boulevard. Nine challenges will be presented to registrants based on themes of:

- Patient-centred services
- Frontline staff engagement
- The overdose crisis
- Mental health and substance use

And of course, because anything could happen with that many innovative people in a room together, there's a wild card category for an out-of-the-box solution.
